

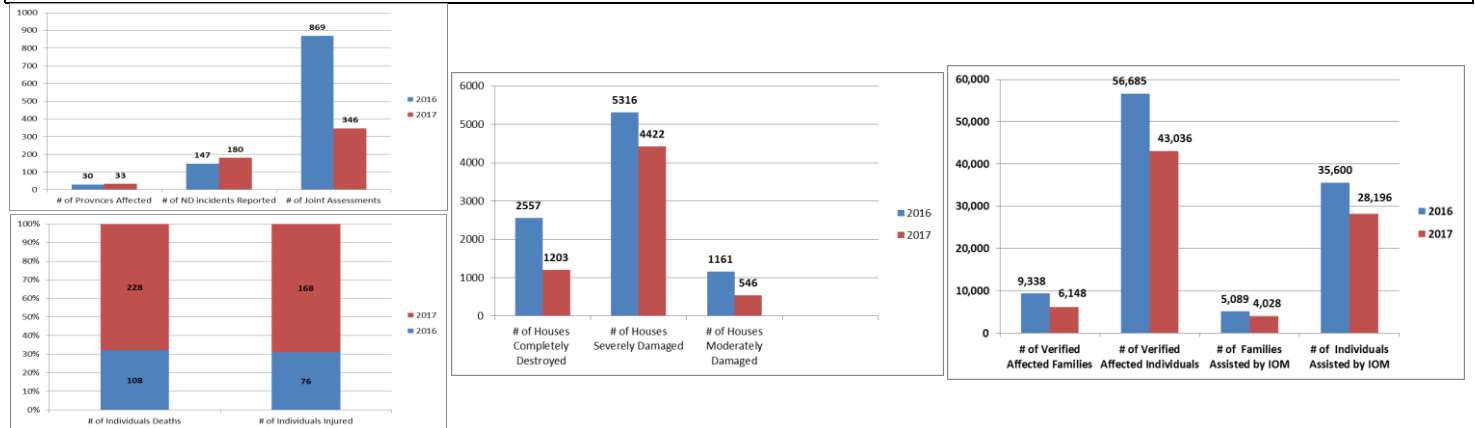

Natural Disasters, Coordination and DRR activity UPDATE: 11 May - 17 May, 2017

Bamyan:

- As per initial report obtained from ANDMA on 12 May, 49 families were affected by flood in Yakawlag II, Kahmard, Waras district. IOM along with ANDMA, Provincial Council and District Authority deployed to the affected areas and so far found 45 families in need of relief items. The assessment is ongoing and the distribution is expected to take place on 20 May.
- Ten families were reportedly affected by flood in Panjab district, Action Aid along with WFP and district authority conducted an assessment and found ten families in need of relief items. The distribution will be coordinated on 18 May and distribution will place on the same day.

Herat:

As result of flood in Obe district, six families were affected and around 80 families were at risk of flood. A joint assessment was deployed to the location on 17 May however the team return due to the road closure. The assessment team will be mobilized on 18 May to verify the needs of the affected families.

Badghis:

As per initial information obtained from ANDMA and Provincial council, 200 families were reportedly affected and 22 person sustained injuries by flood in Jawand district. As per PDMC meeting, the area is insecure, therefore PDMC decided to assess the situation by ANA helicopter and report on the findings. due to accessibility constraints, ANDMA committed to distribute cash assistance to the affected families.

Samangan:

As per initial report obtained from ANDMA on 09 May, 45 families were affected by flood in Aybak and Khuram Sarbagh district. The assessment team deployed to affected areas on 10 May and found 15 families in need of relief items. On 16 May, IOM distributed NFIs while WFP covered food needs of affected families.

Baghlan:

As result of flood on 07 May, 173 families were affected in Banu, Pul-e-Khumri, Nahren and Jelga and Doshi districts. IOM along with ACTED, WFP, ANDMA and RRD deployed to affected areas and found 76 affected families in need of relief items. The distribution is planned for this week, IOM will distribute NFIs, while ACTED will distribute tent and blankets and WFP will cover food needs of affected families.

Paktia:

38 families were reportedly affected by flood in Zadran district on 15 May. IOM along with ANDMA, RRD, DAIL and ARCs conducted an assessment and verified 38 families in need of relief items. The distribution is planned for next week; IOM will distribute NFIs while ANDMA will distribute cash assistance to address the food needs.

Badakhshan:

As a result of heavy rainfall on 23 April, 100 families were reportedly affected in Share Buzurg district. On 15-16 May, IOM together with ANDMA and WFP conducted an assessment and found 39 families in need of relief items. IOM will cover NFI needs while ANDMA committed to distribute food items, the distribution is planned on 20 May.

In a separate incident, On 16 May, 20 families were reportedly affected by flood in Argo district. IOM along with ANDMA initiated an assessment on 17 May, the distribution will take place once the assessment is concluded.
