**Natural Disasters, Coordination and DRR activity UPDATE: 24 May - 30 May, 2017**

**Ghor:**

- As per initial report obtained from ANDMA on 07 May, 18 families were reportedly affected by storm and heavy rainfall in Firoz Koh district. ANDMA together with PAT, PC, Governor representative conducted an assessment from 08 till 20 May and found 57 effected familis in need of relife items. PDMC members comitted to cover the needs for NFIs and food items.
- In a separte incident on 17 May, 200 families were reportedly affected by flood in Firoz Koh district. ANDMA along with PAT, PC, Governor representative conducted an assessment on 22 May and found 93 effected families in need of relife items. PDMC members comitted to cover the NFI and food needs of the affected families.

**Badghis:**

As per initial report obtained from ANDMA on 16 May, 200 families were reportedly affected and 22 sustained injuries by flood in Jawand district. The initial assessment was completed on 21 May and District Disaster Management Committees found 640 affected families which is not confirmed by PDMC. PDMC to verify the figures follow by provision of relief assistance. The district is insecure and accessible thus humanitarian organizations cannot access the affected areas.

**Kunar:**

As result of heavy rainfall on 21 May, two families were reportedly affected in Dara-e-Pech district. ANDMA together with WFP, IMC, DG, RRD conducted an assessment on 24 May and found two families in need of relief items. On 30 May, IMC distributed NFIs while food needs has been referred to WFP and ANDMA.

**Jawzjan:**

As result of riverbank erosion during the month of May, 20 families were reportedly affected in Qarqeen district. IOM along with ANDMA, SCI, WFP,ACTED, government line departments and provincial council member deployed for an assessment on 23 May and found 56 affected families in need of relief items.The distribution is planned on 05 June, IOM will distributed emergency shelter, blanket, solar module and family tents while SCI will distribute household and kitchen kit and WFP will cover food needs of affected families.

**Badakhshan:**

As per initial report obtained from ANDMA on 15 May, 297 families were reportedly affected by flood in Jurm district. An assessment team consisting of IOM and WFP deployed to affected area on 23-24 May,the team found 256 affected families in Lairauk, Khaa and Nowuk villages that were in need of relief items (NFIs and FI). IOM will distribute NFIs (family, blanket, solar, emergency shelter module and family tents) while WFP will cover food needs of the affected families .
