

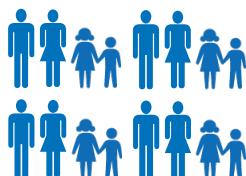
IOM Afghanistan

North Waziristan Displacement Response



24 July 2014

Ongoing military operations in Pakistan's North Waziristan Agency (NWA) have displaced some 15,195 families (UNHCR estimate as of 23 July 2014) on both sides of the Afghanistan-Pakistan border. The majority of the families have been displaced into Afghanistan's Khost and Paktika provinces. IOM is responding to the needs of Afghan families who have returned from North Waziristan, working closely with government and humanitarian partners.

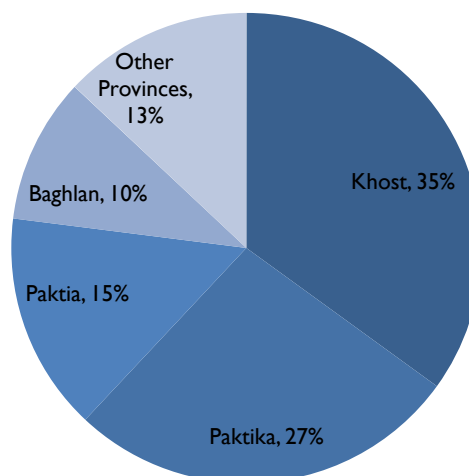

Families interviewed by IOM have spent **an average of 29 years out of the country**. Because these families have been living outside of Afghanistan for so long, reintegration support will be vital.

IOM distributions took place from 20-21 July in Matoon district of Khost, where 152 families were assisted, and Orgun and Sarobi districts of Paktika, where 48 families were assisted. With funding from the Government of Japan, IOM provided each family with a non-food item (NFI) kit. Hygiene kits provided by a partner agency were also distributed. As of 24 July, IOM has assisted a total of 338 displaced Afghan families in Khost and Paktika.

Emergency Shelter support is urgently needed in the immediate term. As soon as these immediate needs are met, longer-term reintegration solutions need to be pursued.

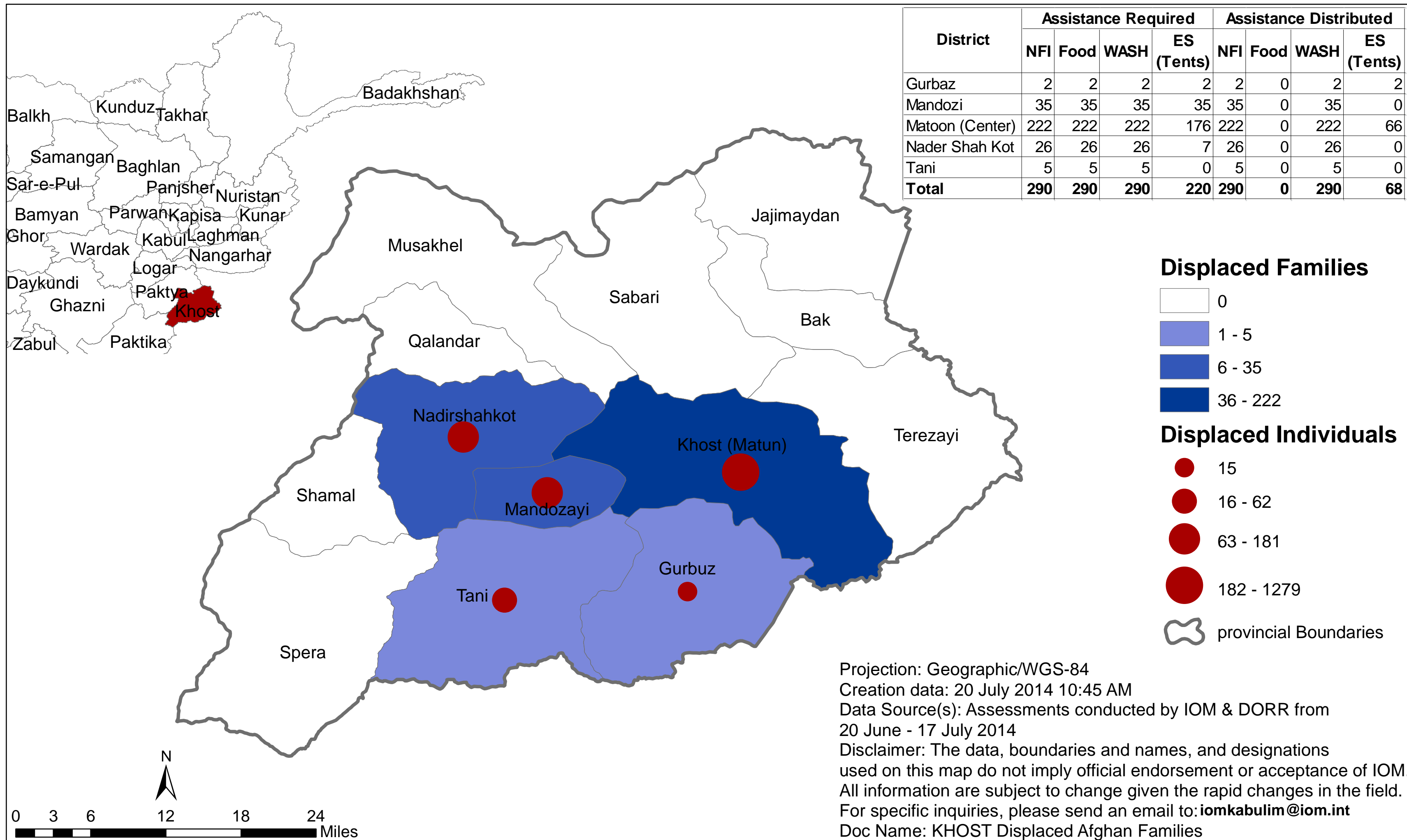

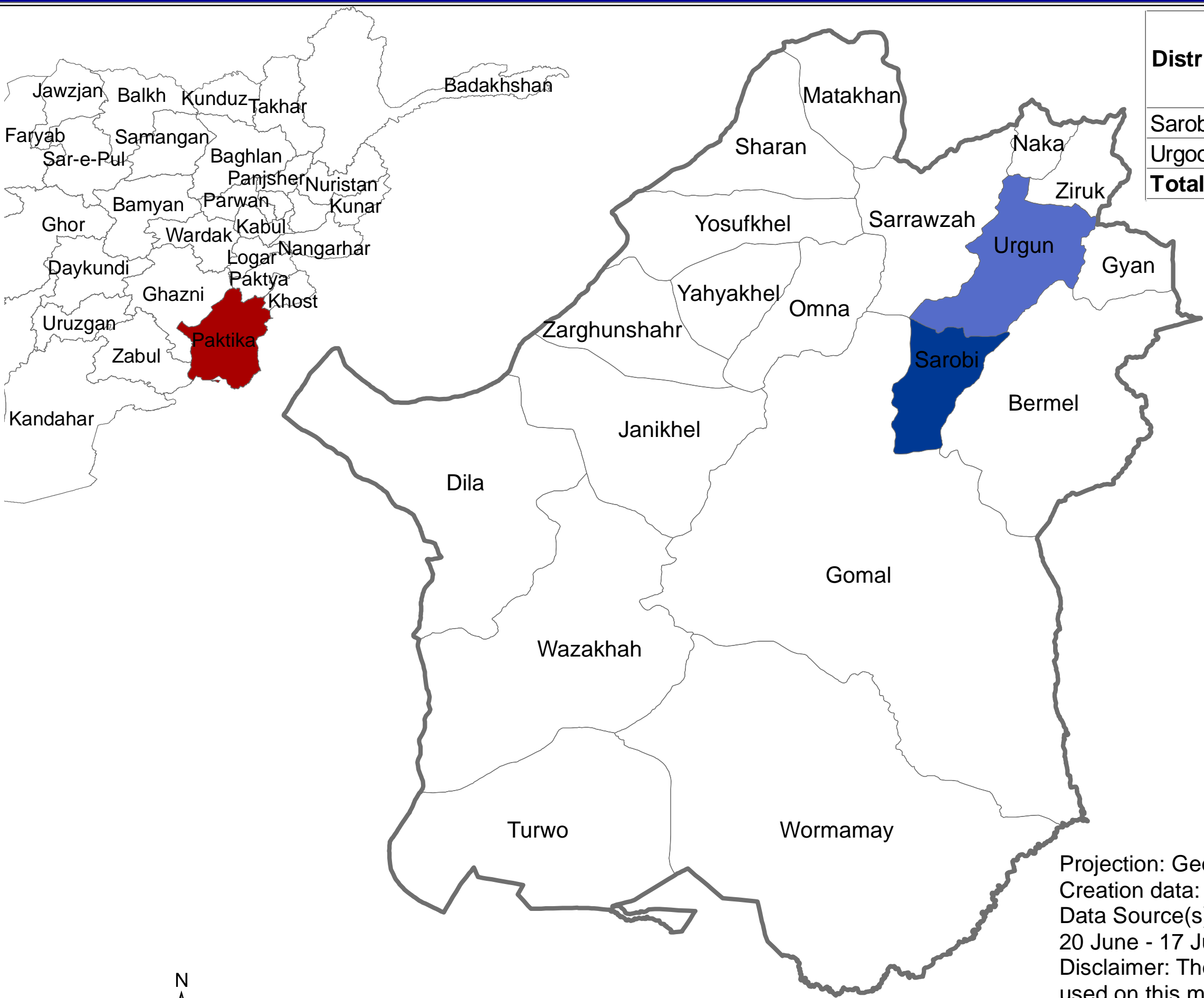

Displaced Afghan Families from Pakistan in Paktika, Afghanistan as of 17 July 2014

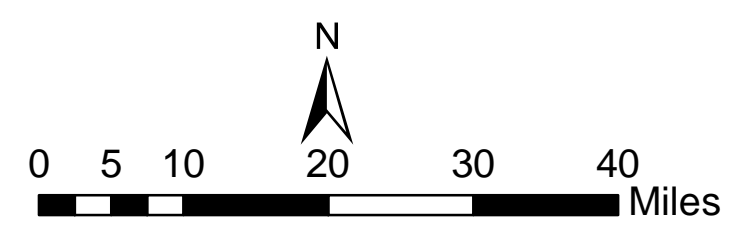
