



**Reporting Period:** 15-28 August 2014

**Incidents Update:** Three new natural disaster incidents were reported.

### East Region:

**Nangarhar Province:** As per initial information obtained from community representative on 21 August, as a result of flooding, around 33 families were affected in Dara-I-Nur district (Satan, Lama, Tak, Chowal and Muchganadwol villages). IOM, NRC and ANDMA will conduct assessment of the affected families on 31 August and will coordinate the response once the assessment is finalized.

### Central Highland Region:

**Bamyan Province:** As per initial information shared by ARCS and district governor on 26 August, reportedly around 70 families in Sabz Qala village of Saighan district were under threat of possible mountain slide. A joint assessment was conducted by IOM, SCI, ANDMA, ARCS, Directorate of Mine, representative from geology department (Bamyan University) and DDMC members of Sayghan district. No houses were found damaged, however fifteen houses were found to be under direct threat of mountain slide. PDMC meeting will be held to discuss mitigation measures, RRD committed to provide 36 tents to families inhabited near the mountain.

### North Region:

**Mazar Province:** As per initial information obtained from CDC and Kishindi district governor on 17 August, as a result of a landslide, fifteen houses were reportedly destroyed in Merzayee village of Kishindi district. A joint assessment was conducted by PIN, CDC and district government representative on 18 August. Twelve families were found affected (eight houses

destroyed). PIN committed to provide tents, WFP will provide food items while DRC will provide cash assistance to the affected families.

### **Southeast Region:**

**Khost Province (Update):** As per initial information from ANDMA in Khost on 1 August 2014, 348 families were reportedly affected by flooding in several villages of Matun district. A joint assessment team consisting of IOM, ANDMA, DoAIL, IRC and ARCS initiated the identification of the affected families. In total 284 families (1,762 individuals) were found to be affected, including

five individuals who sustained injuries. IOM provided family and blanket modules to 111 families, IRC provided NFIs to 173 families, RRD assisted 284 families with the provision of hygiene promotion kits while WFP provided food items to all affected families on 19 August.
