INVITATION TO APPLY FOR ELIGIBILITY AND TO SUBMIT PROPOSAL

The International Organization for Migration (IOM), in cooperation with the Government of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan, has been providing humanitarian post-arrival and transportation assistance to vulnerable undocumented (unregistered/non-refugee) returnees from neighboring countries.

This time, IOM is soliciting bids from non-governmental organizations (NGOs) based in Afghanistan for the Project Service Provider at Islamqala border and Guzarah Transit Center in Herat province and Milak border and Zaranj Transit Center in Nimroz province for humanitarian post-arrival assistance. More information about the scope of services is available in “Instruction to Bidders”.

In order to obtain a complete set of the “Instructions to Bidders”, interested bidders must have At least three (3) years proven experience in operating and transit centre(s) or camp(s) for returnees, refugees or IDPs, two (2) years of which must be in Afghanistan and as well providing proper credentials and copy of their NGO’s registration under the Ministry of Economy to the IOM Logistics Department by sending email to iomkabulprocurement@iom.int from **26th July to 2nd August 2018 between 09:00 and 15:00 hours**.

Only NGOs found to be eligible will receive the complete bidding documents via email after sending the above required documents.

A pre-proposal meeting will be held in the same IOM office located *House # 28, Street# 3, Ansari Square, Shahr-e-Naw (opposite to German Clinic) Kabul, Afghanistan* on **5th August 2018 at 14:00 hours, Kabul time**, where all details of the project will be discussed. Attendance to the conference is mandatory.

The deadline for submission of sealed bids will be **12 August 2018 before 14:00 hours**.
