Eligibility for obtaining a complete set of ITB (Instruction to Bidders) is that interested bidders must provide the following documents:

- Having license for **TVET** trainings from **MoLSA** (Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs)
- The company update business license issued by ministry of Commerce and AISA)
- Provision of documents for similar working experience with UN Agencies or other International Organizations in **last 5 years.**

The above required documents should be sent through email to iomkabulprocurement@iom.int as of Sunday **21 February 2021 and latest by Tuesday 02 March 2021 before 04:30PM.** Only Eligible Contractors will receive the complete bidding documents via email.

A pre-bidding meeting will be held at IOM office located at Street No. 3, House No. 28 Ansari Square, Shahr-e-Naw, (Opposite to old German Clinic) Kabul, Afghanistan on **Thursday 04 March at 02:00PM,** where all details of the project will be discussed.

Bids shall be valid for a period of (90) days after submission of Bids and shall be delivered to the BEAC at House No 28, Street No 3, Ansari Square, Shar e Now, (Opposite to German Clinic), Kabul Afghanistan on or before **Wednesday 10 March 2021, at 02:30PM.** Late submission of bids will not be accepted.

IOM reserves the right to accept or reject any bids, and to cancel the procurement process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without obligation to inform the affected Bidder/s of the ground for IOM action.
