



Return of Undocumented Afghans from Pakistan

Update as of 30 November 2015

A total of 95,042 undocumented Afghans have spontaneously returned or been deported through Torkham border with Pakistan between January and 30 November 2015.

As expected, return levels are declining in line with the onset of winter.

Spontaneous returns were at their lowest level so far this year in November. However, the total number of returns and deportations remained slightly elevated compared with November 2014 (2,375 vs. 1,899).

IOM assisted 1,087 returnees and deportees out of 2,375 in total, for an assistance rate of 46%.
