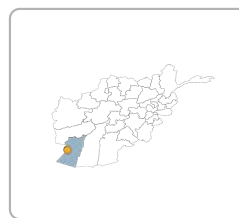
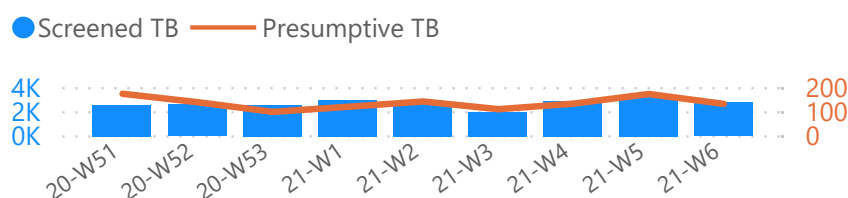


TUBERCULOSIS (TB) SCREENING

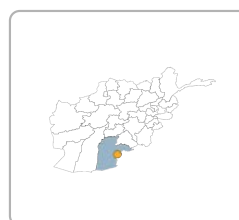
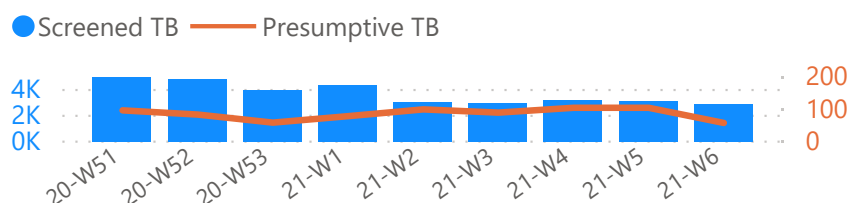
Under Migration Health's Global Fund multi-country TB grant, a total of 8,835 undocumented Afghans were screened for tuberculosis in IOM Transit Centers over the past week. Of the total screened, 3,929 persons were screened during OPD consultations, 291 suspects were identified, all 291 were tested and 3 persons were confirmed as positive TB cases.



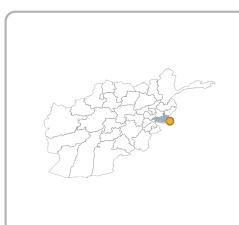
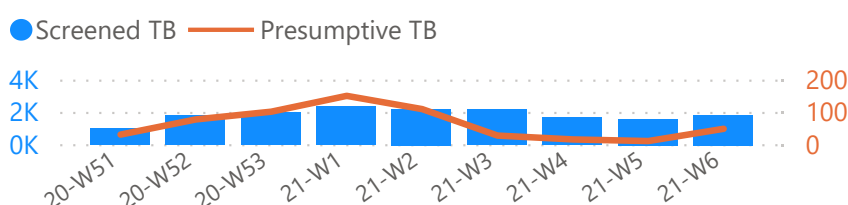

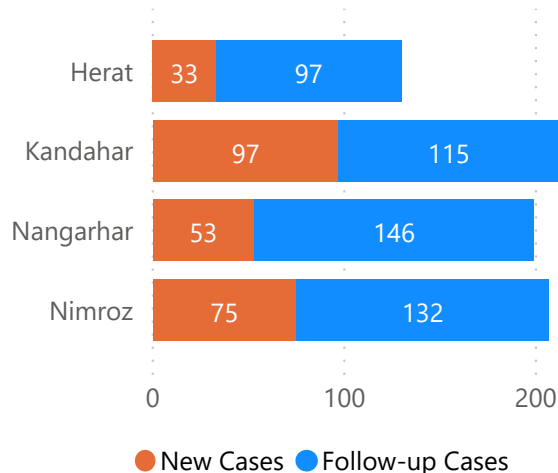
